

1ST ANNUAL HOLY CROSS CANNING COMPETITION

 October 8. One will be used to judge, the other three will be highlighted & sold at the Country Store at the Fall Festival.
- We will have <u>both an Adult and Junior Competition</u>. Children or Young Adults age 8-18 can enter the Junior Competition.
- Blue Ribbon Winners for each category will receive Bragging Rights!
- The overall most impressive entry will receive a 12 pack of Canning Jars with lids and a \$20 gift card.
- Categories include: Dill pickles, Pickled Beans (Green or Waxed), Pickled Asparagus, Pickled Beets, Whole or Quartered Tomatoes, Salsa, Pasta/Pizza Sauce, Sauerkraut, Relish, Chow-Chow, Jams & Jellies, and Horseradish.
- Entries must have been canned within the past year (after October 2018).
- All jars should be labeled on their lid only. Use plain white label with title of entry and date of preservation.
