A Message from Father



Buried Treasure

Have you been on a treasure hunt? Have you found something of great value? The first thing that comes to my mind is how so many people enjoy going to rummage sales, estate sales or auctions. There might be a treasure there just waiting to be discovered. Its exciting to find a great find!!

Today's Gospel is about Jesus teaching us about the coming Kingdom of God. Jesus said to his disciples: "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field." (Matthew 13.44).

The requirements to be a successful Cantor include a strong singing voice, ability to encourage the people to join in the songs and dedication to the ministry of music.
