A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



Come and Eat Without Cost!

How delightful! In today's First Reading from Isaiah 55.1-3, the Lord says, "All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money, come, receive grain and eat; come, without paying and without cost." What a joy!

Did you notice that the word "come" is used three times in that short Scripture verse? The Lord paid the price for us.

We "come" to Him without cost.

However, at times, we are tempted to pass judgement on someone in need. We would think or say, "Well, that person deserves what he/she gets." "You did it to yourself. It's your problem, not mine."

We can become a bit self-righteous at times.

It's not that way with Christ. "Come" without cost. I am so overwhelmed and inspired by what happens here at Holy Cross at the Bus Barn on Mondays and Wednesdays. Those in need "come"



to pick up a box of food. 90% of the food is perishable. It's produce, meat, bread, and dairy products. No questions are asked. The only requirement is that they "come" in a vehicle and have a driver's license. On Mondays, there is an average of 90-115 people who "come." On Wednesdays, 135-150 people "come." 10,000 lbs of food is given away without cost twice a week! There are 16-18 faithful volunteers who "come" to serve the needs of the hungry. Half of them are members of Holy Cross.

We are to be Christ to others. Even if they don't deserve it!

Today's Gospel (Matthew 14:13-21) is the account of Jesus feeding the crowds from a basket of five loaves and two fish. All were fed. There were twelve wicker baskets of fragments left. This passage is a foreshadowing of the Eucharist. They were hungry and were fed.

Our true hunger is for the Eucharist. Jesus gives us the True and Living Bread, His Real Presence in the Eucharist is there for us when we "come" to Mass. Jesus gives us what we need. Actually, He gives us more than we need. We are to follow Christ's example and give without cost to those who "come" to us.

What do those roles??



Accompanist – The accompanist is responsible to provide accompaniment for the hymns and acclamations during the Mass. Accompaniment skills are required, and knowledge of the Catholic Mass is preferred. *This is a paid position.*

Cantor (Song Leader) - The Cantor is both a singer and leader of the congregational song. The Cantor has the responsibility for any songs or hymns that require solo passages, leading the assembly, and inviting the assembly in hymns and acclamations used throughout Mass. The requirements to be a successful Cantor include a strong singing voice, ability to encourage the people to join in the songs and dedication to the ministry of music. Being a Cantor does not require being in any of the choirs. This ministry is open to high school/adult singers.
